- Load/unload vehicle with required equipment and tools for the day's activities.
- Charge equipment as needed.
- Provide care/maintenance for survey equipment.
- Learn operation of survey equipment.
- Monitor daily supplies in vehicles and re-stock as needed.
- Inform crew leader of problems or project related observations.
- Assist crew leader with data management and computer transfer.
- Successfully complete required safety trainings and perform work in accordance with provided handbook and training protocols.

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills for the effective engagement of the team

- Operation of survey equipment a plus
- Read and interpret maps and plans
- Basic computations using calculator or hand-held computer.

Physical Requirements:
